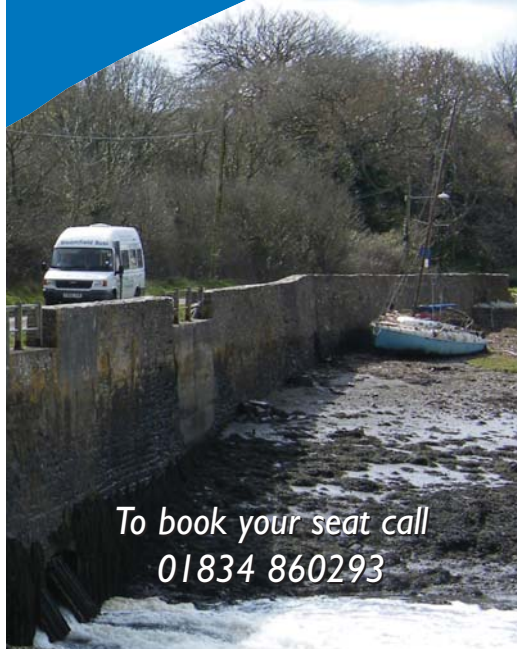


Bloomfield Bus

Bookings can be made up to a week in advance but must be accepted at least 1 hour before the bus departs from Narberth. If you get the answer phone, please leave a message stating your name, contact number, pick up point and time. We will confirm your booking.

Fares:

To use the service you must be a member of the Narberth and District Community and Sports Association. Membership to use the bus is free, just ask the driver for a membership form.

Bloomfield Bus Sunday Service Fares:

Adult £5.00 all day/£3.00 return/£2.00 single
Children £2.50 all day/£1.50 return/£1.00 single
Children 4-16yrs go free during the school holidays
All Wales Bus pass holders travel free of charge

The historic market town of Narberth lies in the heart of the Landsker Borderlands. Why not take an hour or two to stroll around the town's unique selection of shops and cafés. If you fancy exploring further afield the countryside surrounding Narberth and the Cleddau Estuary has a rich and varied history. Why not choose one of a number of walks in the area or pack a picnic and enjoy a leisurely afternoon in beautiful surroundings.

9 Suggested short walks on route include:

- Minwear/Canaston Woods walks with distances from 1.25 miles (2km) 40 min
- Lawrenny circular walk 2.8 miles (4km) 1 hour
- Landshipping to Coedcanlas circular 5 miles (8km) approx 2hrs walking time
- Carew to Cresswell Quay circular 4.9miles (7.8km) approx 2.5hrs

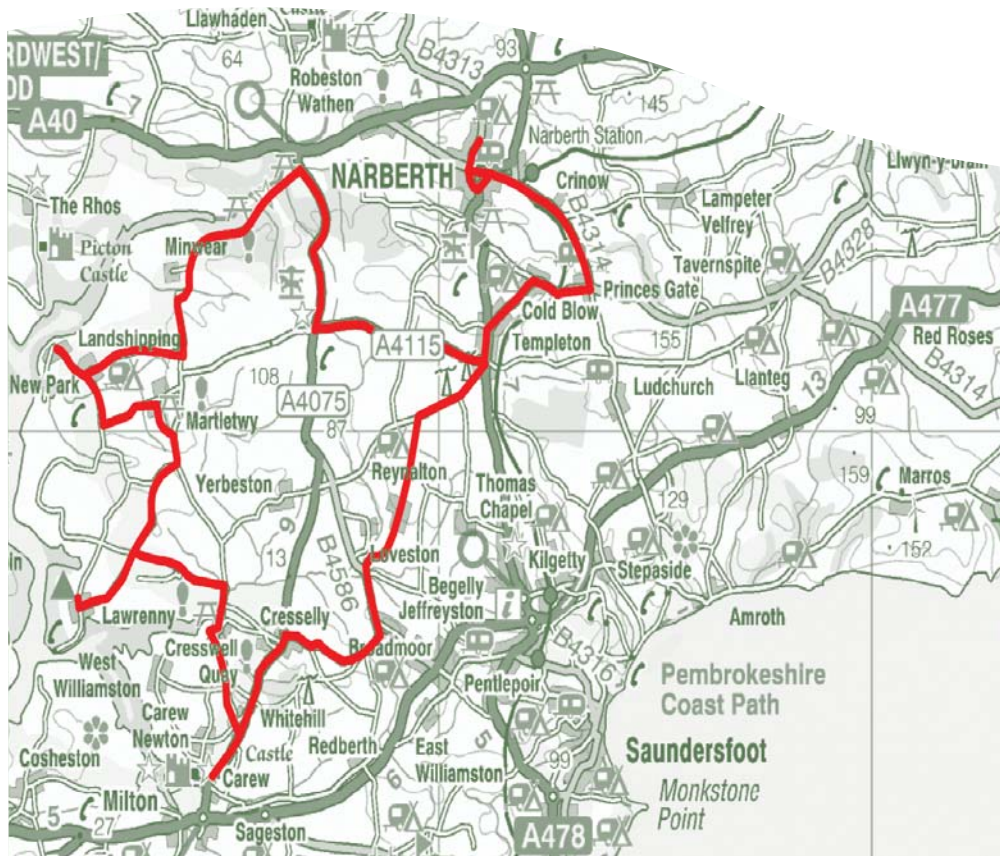
